## Provide examples

Bring evidence or examples of work you have done. If you can't bring it you can bring photos

Think about your experience and transferable skills in advance and use these to help give you examples in a competency style interview

## STARR Method

Use the **STARR** Method to give your answers enough detail and structure



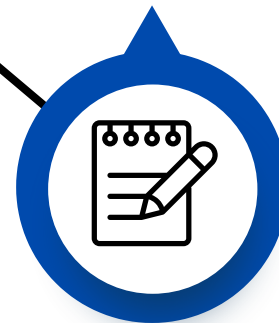
## Carry out research

Do some research about the company - our website has lots of information about us, and our social media will provide you with up to date news and activity



## Bring notes

You can bring notes to your interview - use these to help prompt your responses



### Use the **STARR** method:

**Situation**

**Task**

**Action**

**Result**

**Reflect**
